At the outbreak of war between Germany and Russia he was imprisoned by the Russian MEWD on June 22, 1941 but escaped on June 30, 1941.

In July 1941 he led Latvian Partisans in the fight against Russia.

From July 10 until October 10; 1941 he was with the Schutsmannschaft in Riga.

He was appointed "Kreis-Chef" of the District Abrehaen from October 10, 1941 until May 20, 1945.

On May 20, 1945 he joined the "Lettische SS-Freiwilligen-division".

His name was mentioned in the "Ehrenblatt" of the German Army on August 15, 1944 for bravery in action. War Morit Gross 2nd Class with swords.
