- 1. Enclosed herewith as attachment A is a translation of a letter written by Identity 1 to Identity 2. It was obtained through the services of a Headquarters covert scatact who is in alone accomplation with Identity 2. Identity 2's only interest in this affair apparently is excell to bring the matter to the attention of the proper OFFCET representatives.
- 2. Attachment B is a translation of the amond letter from identity 1 to Identity 2.
- 3. Attentions C is a translation of a note from Identity 8 to Identity 1 which was enclosed in the letter of paragraph 2 above.
- 4. Attachment D is a letter from Meanthly 2 to Identity 1 which can be utilized to establish bone fides with the latter. The earbon copy of this latter has already been mailed to identity 1.
- 5. As will be mident upon personal of attachment A, three separate opportunities for exploitation exist, namely:
  - a. The positive and operational intelligence in the possession of Identity 1's mother.
  - b. The "angle" channel established by Identity 1 between kimmelf and his friend in Latvia.
  - c. The agreement by the sea captain to establish a group to gather intelligence in Latvia on Identity 5's behalf.
- 6. MA has been requested on Identity 1 and you will be notified by orble spon its receipt. At that time is is requested that Identity 1 be contacted utilizing attachment D and be debriefed regulating.

Once contact has been established with Identity 1, he can also be used to facilitate the debriefing of his mother and of Identity 5 if you feel it advisable to interview the latter at this time. It is full that a local Latvian, besides revealing his AIS connections, would also not be able to secure the required degree of full confidence and cooperation and therefore it is further requested that a staff number undertake to establish the foregoing contact or contacts if at all practicable.

7. In view of the relationship apparently existing between identity 2 and identity 3 it is suggested that it might be advisable to query the appropriate local CONCE officials prior to offerting the foregoing contact with identity 1.

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## Translation from Lat day

Trday I construed your letter ac well as this strange note from the court, old man. I would like to ask for your advice again, as I do not interested it byself. The situation is more than umplement for me, as I have achieved quite a lot but there was still such more that could have been done. As you could see from my lact letter, I was able with the help of the captain to organize a completely reliable and effective mode of communication, as it is now possible for me to correspond through a regular sail channel. I have told my friend about our interests and have indicated to him where to look for leads (prospective recruits). I also told him I would like to correspond by air (redio). Is other words, I have started a rather complicated mechanism which cannot be stopped as easily as the old man imagines. Presides, I would not even there stop the whole thing, as otherwise the people over there would think of mr as a fool, or they might think I consider those to be fools.

After all, this is not a child's play. If there should actually be some important reasons for discontinuing everything that has been started. it should certainly be made known to me in such a very and form that there would be no misunderstandings. When we must last time, I emplained to the cld can that my friend is not working amywhere, but is recovering from TH which he contracted in Siberia. I saked if I could send him medicine and packages, so he sould exist on that without working, and instead do some work for us. This was approved by the old man and he promised to cover the expenses. Therefore I informed my friend that he should be in no burry to look for a job and that support would be provided. Now I feel that I have let my friend down. I am unable to send the promined remar from my own cornings. Meany is necessary not only for living, but also for traveling around so that it would be possible to collect some information and organice constiting. Now in the event I chould receive cord some day that everything is in order for radio communications and the only thing left in to listen to each other, I would be like a fish on dry lend, as I have no equipment and cannot obtain it here. All in all you can see that this is like "ploring with throad" and I can in no very be entiafied with it. First of all, I would like things to be clear, since I am idealogically devoted to this comes and one segment stop on like some machine. Also I would like to tell you that if things go on like this, I have means at my disposal whereby I could develop interest in my work in another place, closer to where I am. My mother has brought with her some information which I could make good ase of as 14 is very important

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to the islanders (Aritish) and they would be very grateful to so for this information, as it concerns the fate of one of their employees. With the belp of this case, I could establish contact and they have people for whom other matters are much more important than the investigation of "biographic tata". This has been demonstrated many times.

Now I would like to have your ideas on this subject briefly and clearly. Vould it be possible for you to determine the reasons for such actions? If he (Identity 8) should satually have some reasons for not coming and he really is obliged to go away for deveral menths, than I feel he should at least have left bodied some replacement whom I could contact when necessary. And such a necessary writes in the very mear future. In other words, looking at it from my viewpoint, I and my friends are bring treated like "treah", without consideration of the fact that all this is connected with a great deal of risk.

I can have my friend establish content with trose persons about whom you wrote, without any risk. If he sends greetings from you, trust and understanding can surely be gained. I am so upset and have written you so much that there is no more space left to write about mother's stories. It is clear that the people over there are working with great entimelant and faith and I would certainly be very much achieved if they should become distillustoned due to their content with so.

I am awaiting your answer soon.

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## Promplatice from Latvian

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All of me wish, who and your family a Happy new fame. As you know, my mother arrived (from the Latvinn 8SH) on December 5th. In spine of her age she is very alert and surprises me with her good memory. She has been telling me a lot knd has had no end of experiences, so that one could write a whole book from what she told us. I shall write you mare details some other time, but in general I can say that Communism has resched its ideal of equality, since no one has anything any more. The people are very well informed on world events, both through Listening to the radio and by reading between the lines in their own newspapers. Everyone bopes and write for a change. The people's attitude or state of sind is like a sensitive seismograph, which records all the nimite changes and disturbances in the world situation. As I said before, I shall write you more in datail soon and elso (Identity 3) has maked for a meeting on behalf of your organisation.

How I have another very complicated matter on which I have to request your immediate advice and belp. Some time ago I was able to collect some interceting information. There was a captain best (from the Latvien SER) who had to pick up a new fishing vessel from (Identity &'s) shippard. This emphasis had formerly been in some connection with (Identity 5) and it was established that he was a completely reliable man to deal with. So (Identity b) also became acquainted with this man through (Identity 5) and I sent a code to my friend (in Latvis) through him, so that we can communicate. So far everything would be in order. This evening (Identity k) told me that according to (Identity 5) as Estonian from the other side has just been in Stockholm, and had gone on to London with some deligation. This Estonian had told (Identity 5) that he was in contact with the above mentioned captain and it turned out that this was really so. Furthermore (Identity 5) told (Identity b) that he had talked to this captain before, and that there were several reliable men at home who would exhaut detailed information on conditions in Latvin, etc., and when that had been done one of them, who has a chance to get onto come finding boxt, would try to lower the boat at the court of Bredon or Horsey and at two name time carry out the collected information. In order to promote this undertaking, (Identity 5) is easé to require 2,000 kronor in U.S. Pollars, which he is to give the Estonian on Thursday, 10 January, when he will be here on his way back (to Estonia) from London. When (Identity h) saked (Identity 5) what he intended to do with the collected information, the latter replied that he would try to get in touch with the American Legation. (Identity 4) thereupon replied that the Americans would simply not take his word, and

that he should get in touch with you in this matter, as it is guite natural that you have been interested in such matters simply from the point of view of the Latvian central organisations. (Identity 5) replied that it might really be the best thing to get in touch with you. I have tried to have this matter evitched in your direction, as I personally have not become involved in anything here so as not to cause the unnecessary improcasion enoug wider circles that I am doing anything (operational). So far everything would be all right, if only (Identity 5) did not have several other persons involved who shared this information: (Identity 6) and a very active can here called (Identity 7). It is my idea that (Identity 4) should first of all convince (Identity 5) that this information should go to you alone and that the other two persons (Identities 6 and 7) should somehow be cut out of the picture. I suggested to (Identity 4) that he should make (Identity 5) understand in a roundsbout way that it would not be difficult to get the necessary funds from you or from my old man (Identity 8), as I would get everything I could use from all of this (sic) and the old man would have to pay for it. For the time being, (Identity 5) will try to borrow the money by Thursday, so he would have something to give the Betorian. I shall meet the "old men" on 19 January, then I will try to explain the situation to him, but whether be will accept it is a different question: I suppose that in view of his centiousness and stingless be will first want to investigate the whole "femily troe", which I am unable to give him at this time. I do not know if you have any funds at your disposal and whether you would be able to help in such a short time. I would like you to be informed on this whole matter, in case (Identity 5) chould write to you. You should not write to him yourself, but (Identity 4) will try to influence him in such a way then be will write to you. If there is enthing else you might have to discuss with (Identity 3), you would write without mentioning a word of this whole matter, but just try to draw his attention to you by some other question and create confidence. I hope that I have expressed gyself cufficiently alearly and you will not misurvierstand me.

In general I am autisfied with the results of my work so far and an awaiting current information from my friend in the near future. The only thing is that it is difficult to come to an agreement with the "old man", as he is not interested in anything but the "fundly true" (sie: probably seems B I data). It is too had one has to work with such a "crimple". I tried to impress on him that one of the two persons who arrived here last summer - the other one went back - had gone to England immediately after being released. I emphasized that the British know their job.

My gother told me that a (Identity 9) was planning to go to Sweden last fall; he had returned from Siberia a year ago and was entire in the underground. So far he has not been seen yet arrowd here, but it might

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be possible to get on his trail to laterts. That would be suite as schievement if he would "come to the surface" again.

My mother also contioned acceptory by the name of (Identity La) and (Identity 11) in a similar connection. Do you have any new names or addresses, so I could give my friend the necessary leads. That about (Identity 12), is be still at Dairnsvuleks - Y want to establish radio communications at all cost. The "old man" are promised to give the radio sets if there should be someone on the other side who could transmit. Let me hear from you seem. All the best
