11. Summary

- a. The new Valdomis organization, created in December 1952, which at first seemed likely to become a definite hindrance to our Latvian unification effort, has not turned out as such. It is receiving no major support among the Latvians and is proving to be quite ineffective. It now appears that it may become just another political faction which will send a representative to the body representing all Latvians in exile.
- b. It is reported that Karlis Zarins, Latvian Minister in London, has chosen an apolitical and popular individual, Karlis Kalnins, to be his principal assistant. Kalnins will replace Kampus, who is to become Latvian charge d'affaires in Spain. We are attempting to determine the significance of this shift in assignments.
- c. The PP portion of Project ASCOB is being revised to bring it into line with the new approved SR program.
