There were no Soviet troops stationed in Kuldiga [N 56-08, E 21-59]. "A large underground depot, reportedly containing rockets, bombs, or atomic bombs" was located approximately five to six kilometers southwest of Kuldiga in the direction of Aizpute [N 56-43, E 21-36]. Near the underground depot there was a Soviet military garrison [Voyenny gorodok] which was off-limits to civilians.
